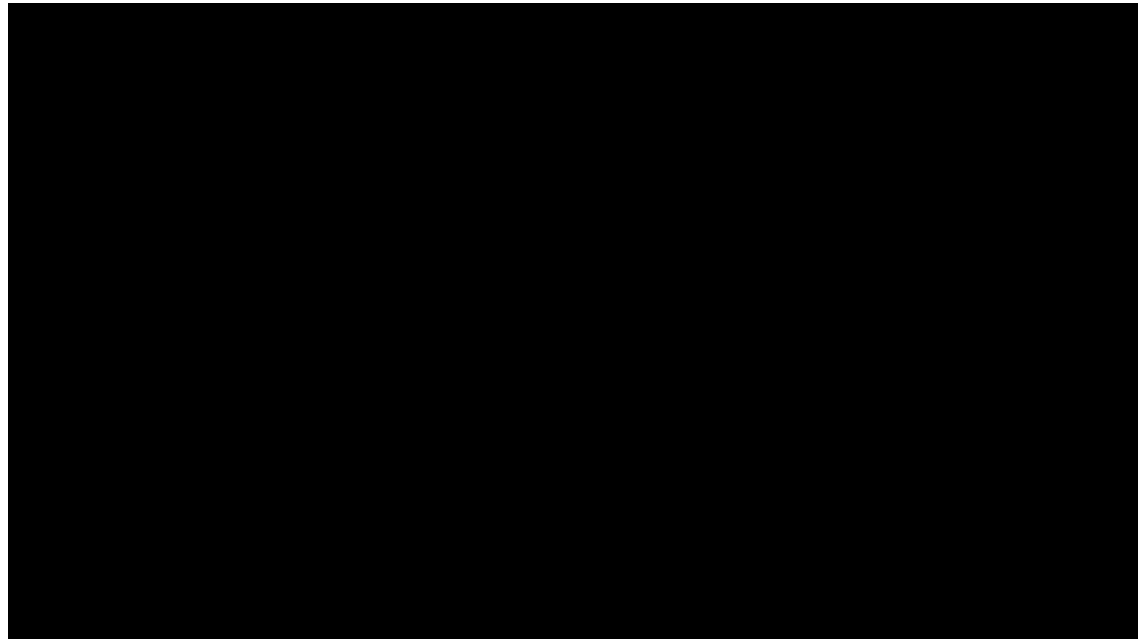

February 2017

- 176/200 participants – 30% international

September 2017

- 176/200 participants – 30% international

February 2018

- Kalajoki – integration
- 176/200 participants – 30% international

May 2018

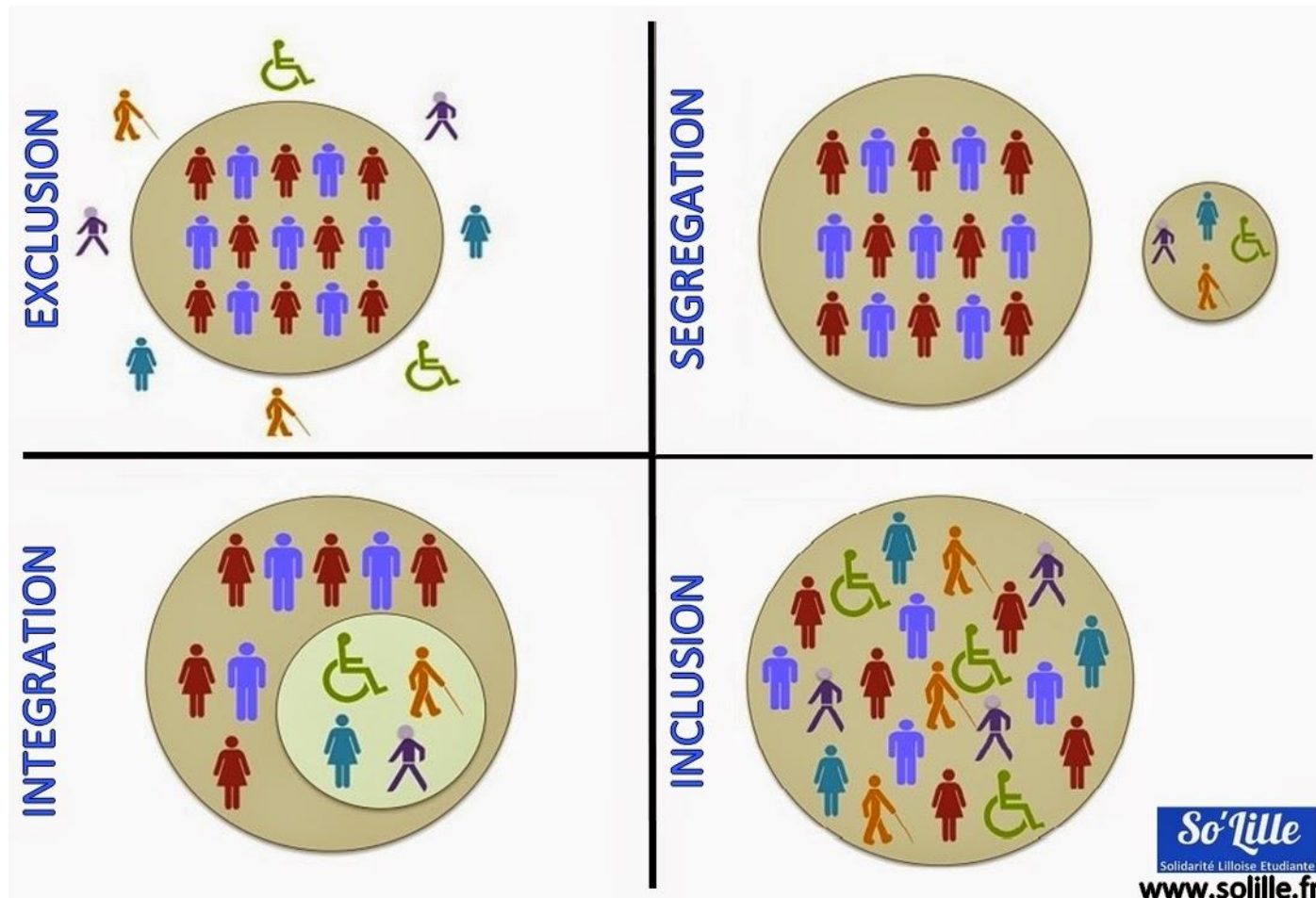
- Pordenone – focus on education and schools
